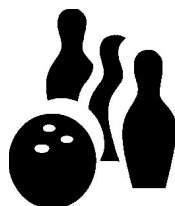

# NEW MEXICO USBC YOUTH STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES



**1. ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association. Residents of New Mexico who are not members of any association may obtain membership by purchasing a card from a local association. **Current membership card must be presented at check-in if requested.**

**2. ENTERING AVERAGES:** Participants must use the highest certified average as of January 1, 2018, if there is no January 1, 2018 average then the previous book average of 2016-2017 (including summer 2017 if it is higher). If none of the above apply, the highest certified average of at least nine (9) games as of **March 24, 2018 will be used and a written verification of average will be provided to tournament officials at the time he/she is scheduled to bowl in the tournament. All others will bowl scratch.** If a bowler is only bowling in a Sport Bowling League, the bowler is required to submit his/her adjusted Sport Bowling average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale (USBC Rule 201c). Tournament management reserves the right to correct any averages and adjust final tournament standings accordingly.

**3. PRIZES AND HANDICAP AWARDS:** Award-Prize Fund fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in the form of Scholarships, and monies will be deposited in the Bowlers Name with the SMART Program. Awards will be presented in each event as follows:

DIVISION A TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES/ALL EVENTS (SCRATCH)

DIVISION B TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES/ALL EVENTS (SCRATCH)

DIVISION C TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES/ALL EVENTS (SCRATCH)

Scholarships will be awarded in at least a 1:10 ratio of participation in each Division of team, doubles, singles and all events (male and female).

**4. CLASSIFIED DIVISIONS:** Competition will be conducted in the following Divisions based on averages:

Division A Team	580 & Up	Division B Team	460 - 579	Division C Team	459 & Below
Division A Doubles	290 & Up	Division B Doubles	230 - 289	Division C Doubles	229 & Below
Division A Singles & All Events	145 & Up	Division B Singles & All Events	115 - 144	Division C Singles & All Events	114 & Below

**5. HANDICAP:** 90% of the bowlers average and 200.

**6. PARTICIPATION:** Each entrant may enter the team event multiple times, subject to the following conditions: **First team score** will count toward all-events score. Not more than two (2) players shall place together more than once. **USBC Rule 315.** Entrants may participate multiple times in the Doubles and Singles event subject to the following conditions: If a participant enters one, **the entrant must enter both events.** These events will be bowled consecutively. **The first doubles and singles scores** will count toward the all-events score. Doubles: The entrant may only place once with the same partner. The entrant must change partners to place again. Singles: The entrant may only place once. **PLEASE LIST SECOND DOUBLES AND SINGLES ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM.**

**7. ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Reserved Entries close Midnight **March 24, 2018.** Entries close 1 hour before squad unless squad is full.

**8. DRESS CODE: USBC RULE 301B WILL APPLY.** Members of the Board of Directors of New Mexico USBC, as a sponsor of this Championship Tournament, require that all bowlers wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament: Slacks, Skirts or walking shorts to the knee, bowling shirts or blouses preferred.

**UNSUITABLE ATTIRE;** Tank tops, work out attire (i.e. Spandex, sweatpants), Short Shorts/Skirts (if a bowlers fingers are below the hemline, the shorts/skirt are considered too short and not suitable). Bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics. No hats or head covers are allowed. Bowlers shall wear authorized bowling shoes.

**VIOLATIONS: Entrants will be required to change into suitable attire. Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl.** Tournament management reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed inappropriately attired without recourse. Attire needed for medical reasons must be discussed with tournament management prior to the tournament.

9. Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants). This is a non-smoking event. No tobacco or alcohol products will be allowed by participants or spectators during the tournament. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the settee area. There will be **NO** use of electronic devices (video games, radios, cell phones, CD Players, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event. Coaching will be allowed, but if it causes a delay in the game, the offending player will be given a zero for each frame they are not ready to bowl. Only bowlers and tournament officials with RVP badges will be allowed in the settee area.

10. **PROTEST:** In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules, the protest must be filed in writing to tournament management no later than seventy-two (72) hours after completion of event **USBC Rule 329**. In case of scoring errors, they should be reported immediately upon discovery.

11. Each bowler must check-in with tournament management at least one (1) hour prior to squad time with USBC cards if requested. **Substitutes will be put in the place of the absent bowler. No lineup changes are permitted.**

12. There will be a \$25.00 NSF check fee.

13. The entrants whose name appears hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree the NEW MEXICO USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event of the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting there from, fires, strikes, lock-outs, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the New Mexico USBC Association.

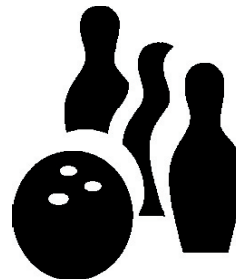
