The candidate must be a current New Mexico USBC member, be active in a USBC youth league, and never have competed in a professional bowling tournament (Pro-AM excluded). Previous recipients may reapply.

The candidate must be a current New Mexico USBC member, be active in a USBC youth league, be compliant with USBC Rule 400, and never have competed in a professional bowling tournament (Pro-AM excluded). If you are the recipient of the Betty Huxtable Scholarship you are not a candidate for the Lionel Jordan Scholarship. Previous recipients may reapply.
