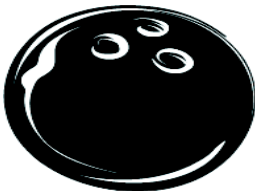

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2015 SENIOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament will consist of Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events.

Tournament is a classified handicap format.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all USBC certified members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association who have reached their 50th birthday at the time of the reserved entry closing date for entry into the tournament. Residents of New Mexico who are not members of any other association may establish eligibility for this tournament by obtaining an associate membership for the sum of \$22.00 or Actual Amount if known - **USBC Rule 300c 2a.**
Current membership card must be presented at check-in.
- 2. ENTERING AVERAGES:** Participants must use the highest certified average for the 2014 - 2015 season. (Summer 2014 - 2015 or Winter 2014 - 2015 averages will be used depending on which 21 game average is higher.) If there is no 21 game 2014 - 2015 average, then the highest certified average of at least twelve (12) or more games as of **October 20, 2015 will be used and a written verification of average will be provided to tournament officials at the time he/she is scheduled to bowl in the tournament. All others will bowl scratch.** Bowlers bowling with opposite hand because of injury or disability must apply for relief, see **USBC Rule 4e.** If a bowler is only bowling in a Sport bowling league, the bowler is required to submit his/her adjusted Sport bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale (**USBC Rule 202a**). Tournament management reserves the right to correct any averages and adjust final tournament standings accordingly.
- 3. PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Prize fund will be returned 100% in each event. Prize ratio will be at least 1 in 10 entries or major fraction thereof in each event. **No substitute may win all events, unless all events entry fee is paid before participation in the tournament.**
- 4. USBC Rule 319d and Rule 319e do not apply.** Substitutes will be put in the place of the absent bowler.
- 5. Singles Divisions:** Super Senior 75+ years of age; Class A 70-74 years of age; Class B 65-69 years of age; Class C 60-64 years of age; Class D 55-59 years of age; Class E 50-54 years of age.
Classified Divisions:
Division 1 Team 660 average and above. Division 2 Team 659 average and below.
Division 1 Doubles 330 average and above. Division 2 Doubles 329 and below.
All Events consists of the Doubles event and the Singles event only. The Handicap All-Events Champion in each division will have their entry fee paid for the USBC National Seniors Tournament. Each champion will also receive the Senior's shirt for the National Tournament. In the event of a tie in the senior championship, the bowler with the highest scratch score will go to the National Senior Tournament
- 6. HANDICAP:** Ninety percent (90%) of 220 average per participant for all divisions.
- 7. PARTICIPATION: DOUBLES AND SINGLES ARE SEPARATE EVENTS. You do NOT have to bowl doubles in order to bowl singles.** Only 1 professional bowler per allowed on a doubles pair. Entrants may participate two (2) times in doubles and singles. The **First doubles and singles** scores will count toward all-events score. **Doubles:** The entrant may only cash once with the same partner. The entrant must change partners to cash again. **Singles:** The entrant may only cash once. **PLEASE LIST SECOND DOUBLES AND SINGLES ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM.**
No more than 2 professional bowlers are allowed. Entrants may participate in the Team Event two (2) times, subject to following the following conditions: **No more than two (2) players shall cash together more than once (USBC Rule 315).**
- 8. ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Reserved Entries Close at midnight, October 20, 2015 (10/20/2015). Otherwise 1 hour before squad time unless squad is full.**
- 9. DRESS CODE:** Members of the Board of Directors of NMUSBC, as sponsor of this Championship Tournament, request that all bowlers wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament; Slacks, Skirts or walking shorts to the knee, bowling shirts or blouses are preferred.
UNSUITABLE ATTIRE; Tank Tops, workout attire (i.e. Spandex, sweatpants), Short Shorts (if a bowlers fingers are below the hemline, the shorts are considered too short and are not suitable), Bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics, **no hats.**
- 10. VIOLATIONS:** Entrants will be required to change into suitable attire. **Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl.** Tournament management reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired without recourse. Attire needed for medical reasons must be discussed with tournament management prior to the tournament.
- 11.** Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants or for intoxication (USBC Rule 303). There will be no use of electronic devices (video games, cell phones, CD players, iPods, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event. Coaching will be allowed but if it causes a delay in the game the offending player will be given a zero for each frame they are not ready to bowl.

12. **PROTEST:** In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules, the protest must be filed in writing to tournament management no later than fifteen (15) days after close of tournament. In case of scoring errors they should be reported immediately upon discovery.
13. Team captains must check in with tournament management at least thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time. Substitutes will be put in the place of the absent bowler. No lineup changes are permitted.
14. There will be a \$ 25.00 NSF check fee.
15. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree the NEW MEXICO USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting there from, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NEW MEXICO USBC Association.
16. **ALL RULES NOT COVERED BY THE ABOVE WILL BE COVERED BY THE USBC CURRENT PLAYING RULES BOOK.**
