



## NEW MEXICO USBC LIONEL JORDAN SCHOLARSHIP

The New Mexico USBC Lionel Jordan Scholarship is awarded annually to a high school senior or college student who is an active New Mexico USBC youth bowler and who has demonstrated outstanding academic achievement. The scholarship recipient will receive \$1,000.00 deposited in their SMART scholarship account.

**Eligibility:** Candidates must be between the ages of 16 and 20 years of age. Candidates may not exceed the age of 20 at the deadline of the application, and have an overall GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale. The candidate must be a current New Mexico USBC member, be active in a USBC certified league, be compliant with USBC Rule 400. If you are the recipient of the Betty Huxtable Scholarship you are not eligible for the Lionel Jordan Scholarship. Previous recipients of the Lionel Jordan scholarship are not eligible.

**Checklist for Scholarship:** Please remember your scholarship application must be completely filled out and contain the following information:

- Complete Application
- Attach 500-word Essay typed and double spaced to the scholarship application
- Attach Current Transcription – (Can attach an electronic copy from school's website it doesn't have to be an official transcript.)
- Attach 3 letters of References from people other than family members. These letters of reference can be from school personnel, church leaders, bowling leaders or other community members.
- Check all spelling and grammar, remember you want this scholarship application to look like a professional document as it is a representation of you.
- Make sure application is signed.
- Attach additional sheets if necessary.

**Incomplete applications will be rejected.**
