1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association. Residents of New Mexico who are not members of any association may obtain membership by purchasing a card from a local association. Current membership card must be presented at check-in if requested.

2. **ENTERING AVERAGES:** Participants must use the highest certified average as of January 1, 2026. If there is no January 1, 2026 average, then the previous highest book average of 2024-2025. If none of the above apply, the highest certified average of at least nine (9) Games as of March 22, 2026 will be used and a written verification of average will be provided at the time he/she is scheduled to bowl. All others will bowl scratch. If a bowler is only bowling in a sport league, the bowler is required to submit his/her adjusted sport average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale. Tournament management reserves the right to correct any averages and adjust final tournament standings accordingly.

3. **PRIZES AND HANDICAP AWARDS:** Prize fund fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in the form of scholarships, and monies will be deposited in the bowler's name with the SMART program. Scholarships will be awarded in at least a 1:10 ratio of participation in each division of team, doubles, singles and all events (male and female). Awards will be presented in each event as follows:

DIVISION A: TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES AND ALL EVENTS

DIVISION B: TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES AND ALL EVENTS

DIVISION C: TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES AND ALL EVENTS

4. **CLASSIFIED DIVISIONS:** Competition will be conducted in the following divisions based on averages:

Division A Team: 580 & Up Division B Team: 460 - 579 Division C Team: 459 & Below

Division A DOUBLES: 290 & Up Division B DOUBLES: 230 - 289 Division C DOUBLES: 229 & Below

Division A SINGLES: 145 & Up Division B SINGLES: 115 - 144 Division C SINGLES: 114 & Below

5. **PARTICIPATION:** Each entrant may enter the team event and doubles/singles event multiple times. No more than two players shall place together more than once. In singles, the entrant may only place once. The first scores bowled in each event will count toward all-event score. Please list second doubles/singles on a separate entry form.

6. **TOURNAMENT DRESS CODE:** Participants will abide by the dress code. Failure to comply could result in disqualification. Prohibited attire includes: torn jeans, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti straps, sweat pants, bib overalls, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics, short shorts or short skirts (skirts/shorts must be longer than fingertips at sides).

7. **ADDITIONAL PARTICIPATION RULES:** This is a non-smoking event. No tobacco or alcohol products will be allowed by participants or spectators during the tournament. There will be no use of electronic devices (video games, radios, cell phones, CD players, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event. Coaching will be allowed, but if it causes a delay of the game, the offending player will be given a zero for each frame they are not ready to bowl. Only bowlers and tournament officials wearing the RVP badges will be allowed in the settee area. Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants).

8. **PROTEST:** In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed in writing with tournament management within 72 hours of the infraction.
