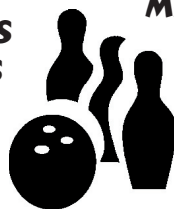

# 2019 WOMEN'S STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament will consist of Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events

Tournament is a classified handicap format.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Tournament is open to all USBC certified members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association. Residents of New Mexico who are not members of any association may obtain membership by purchasing a card from a local association. **Current membership card must be presented at check-in if requested.**
- 2. ENTERING AVERAGES:** Participants must use the highest certified average for the 2017-2018 season. Summer 2017-2018 or Winter 2017-2018 averages will be used depending on which 21 game average is higher. If there is no 21 game 2017-2018 average, then the highest certified average of 21 games as of January 1, 2019 will be used, and if none of the above apply, then at least twelve (12) or more games as of **March 1, 2019 will be used and a written verification of average will be provided to tournament officials at the time she is scheduled to bowl in the tournament. All others will bowl scratch (210).** If the bowler's highest January 1, 2019 average of 21 games or more exceeds her 2017-2018 average by 10 pins or more, she must use that average. If a bowler is only bowling in a Sport Bowling League, the bowler is required to submit her adjusted Sport Bowling league average utilizing the USBC Average Adjustment Scale (USBC Rule 201c). **Bowlers bowling with opposite hand because of injury or disability must apply for relief (Rule 4e).** Tournament management reserves the right to correct any averages and adjust final tournament standings accordingly.
- 3. PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Prize fund will be returned 100% in each event. No substitute may win All Events unless they bowl the original entry's team, doubles and singles event. Prize ratio will be at least 1 in 10 entries. Awards will be presented to SCRATCH winners with the exception of scratch all events. Cash prizes will be awarded in each event on a handicap basis only (except Scratch All-Events). Bowler with the highest individual scratch total pins will have their entry paid to the USBC Queens Tournament and the highest individual scratch total pins with an age of 50 years or older will have their entry paid into the USBC Senior Queens Tournament.
- 4. USBC Rule 319d and Rule 319e do not apply.**
- 5. DIVISIONS:**

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- 6. HANDICAP:** Ninety percent (90%) of 210 averages per participant for all divisions except Scratch All-Events.
- 7. PARTICIPATION:** No more than two (2) professional bowlers are allowed on a team. Only one (1) professional bowler on a doubles pair. Entrants may participate in the Team Event multiple times, subject to the following conditions: **First team score** will count toward All-Events score. **Not more than two (2) players** shall cash together more than once. **USBC Rule 315.** Entrants may participate multiple times in the Doubles and Single event subject to the following conditions: If a participant enters one, **the entrant must enter both events.** These events must be bowled consecutively. The **First doubles and single scores** will count toward all-events score. **Doubles:** The entrant may only cash once with the same partner. The entrant must change partners to cash again. **Singles:** The entrant may only cash once. **PLEASE LIST SECOND DOUBLES AND SINGLES ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM, (USBC RULE 315).**
- 8. RESERVED ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Midnight **February 18, 2019.** Entries close 1 hour before squad time unless squad is full.
- 9. DRESS CODE:** Members of the Board of Directors of NMUSBC, as sponsor of this Championship Tournament, require that all bowlers wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament: Slacks, Skirts or walking shorts to the knee (if fingers are below the hemline the attire is considered too short and is not suitable), bowling shirts or blouses are preferred. No hats or head covers unless approved by NMUSBC for medical reasons. **Dress attire for the 8am squads only will consist of anything that goes to include hats, tank tops, short shorts, leggings, etc. Exceptions: CANNOT wear anything vulgar, lewd or derogatory.**

**UNSUITABLE ATTIRE:** Tank Tops, workout attire (i.e. Spandex, sweatpants, jogging suits), Short Shorts / Skirts (if a bowlers fingers are below the hemline, the shorts are considered too short and are not suitable), Bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics. These rules will be strictly enforced.
- 10. VIOLATIONS:** Entrants will be required to change into suitable attire. **Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl.** Tournament management reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired without recourse. Attire needed for medical reasons must be discussed with tournament management prior to the tournament.
- Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants) or for intoxication. **USBC Rule 303.** There will be NO use of electronic devices (video games, radios, cell phones, CD Players, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event. Coaching will be allowed, but if it causes a delay in the game the offending player will be given a zero for each frame they are not ready to bowl.



12. **PROTEST:** In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules, the protest must be filed in writing to tournament management no later than 72 hours after close of tournament per USBC Rule 329. In case of scoring errors they must be reported immediately upon discovery.
13. Team captains must check in with tournament management at least one (1) hour prior to squad time. Substitutes will be put in the place of the absent bowler. No lineup changes are permitted.
14. There will be a \$25.00 NSF check fee.
15. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree the NEW MEXICO USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NEW MEXICO USBC Association.
16. **ALL RULES NOT COVERED BY THE ABOVE WILL BE COVERED BY CURRENT USBC RULE BOOK.**

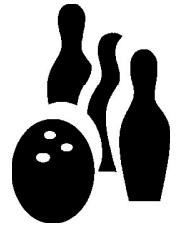
